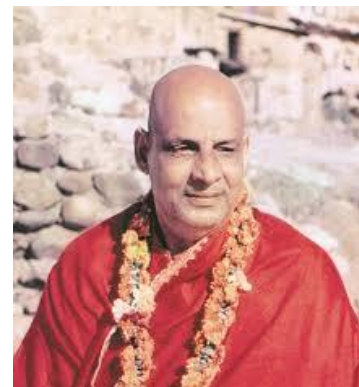
But there's a generation ready to change course. Millennia's are passionate about sustainability. The problem? Many lack the knowledge to make sustainable choices.

Delivered from the cloud, this immersive journey educates and empowers people everywhere to learn actionable steps and Take-home tips that can be implementing immediately.

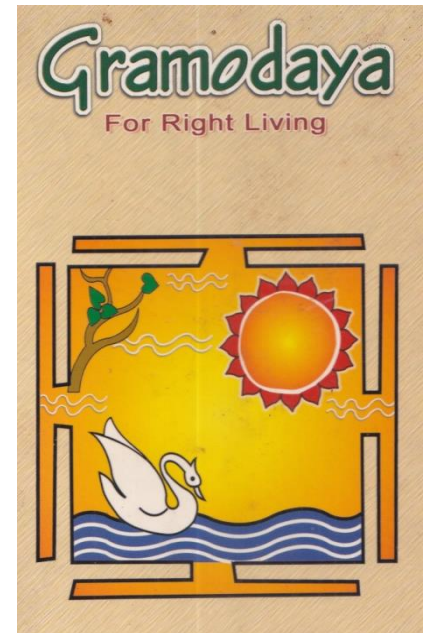

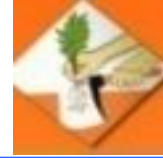

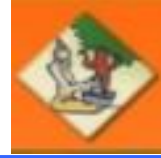

Reduction of Wants – Panacea to all Problems

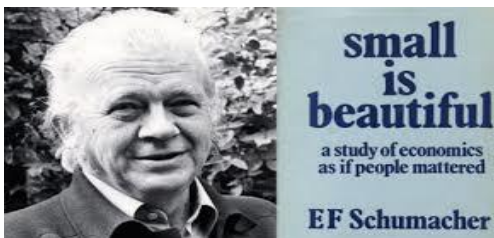
In 1963 E.F. Schumacher wrote “Small is Beautiful - A study of Economics as if People Mattered”. It is still of value to us today. He pointed out then that “The cultivation and expansion of needs is the antithesis of wisdom. It is also the antithesis of freedom and peace. Every increase of need tends to increase one’s dependence on outside forces over which one cannot have control, and therefore increases existential fear. Only by a reduction of needs can one promote a genuine reduction in those tensions which are the ultimate causes of strife and war”.

Science and Technologies Contribution?

By defining cleverly, high energy consumption as better science, and managing with low temperature energy as bullock cart science, 'modern science accelerated the exploitation of fossil energy sources. Harvesting the concentrated non-renewable fossil fuel sources such as coal and petroleum, science neglected and ridiculed low energy, renewable energy, solar, wind gobar gas energies, the primary sources of energies. Another contribution science made was pollution of everything it touched. Science and Technology also spilt nature’s bounties into indigestible polluting “Wastes”.

Holistic View of Life
